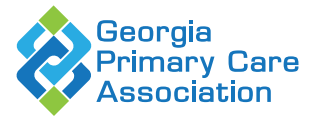
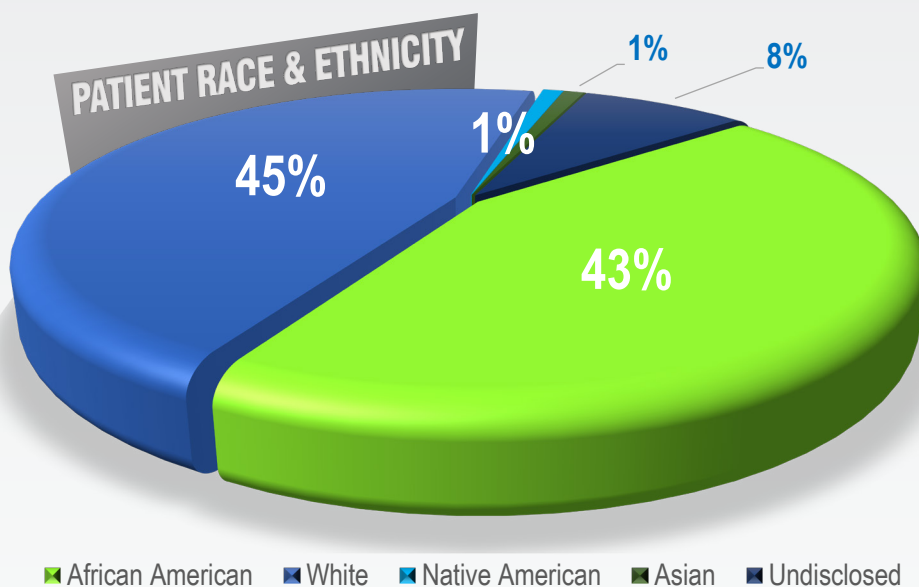

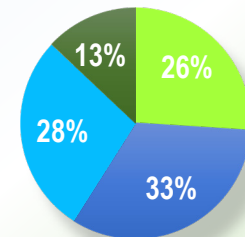


Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) in Georgia

- ◆ 35 FQHCs and 1 FQHC look-alike
- ◆ Serving over 710,000 patients
- ◆ Located in 140 counties with 330 clinic sites
- ◆ The mean annual rate of ER visits for uninsured patients is 25% less in counties with a FQHC compared to those without

Georgia Health Center Employees/Visits

A team of 4,509 dedicated professionals supported 2,182,644 patient visits.

Did you know that health centers in Georgia are economic drivers?

Brought over \$2 in economic activity for every dollar spent. For every 10 health center jobs, five additional jobs were created. In total, health centers in Georgia delivered \$1.5B in economic activity.

U.S. FQHCs

- 1,512 FQHCs operate 17,076 service locations in every state and territory
- FQHCs serve approximately 34 million patients including 10 million children
- 4.1 million patients are 65 years or older
- FQHCs serve 1.5 million homeless patients
- 18% are uninsured and 59% are publicly insured
- 428,312 patients are veterans
- 64% are people of color
- Over 20.5 million patients have low-income
- Over 10 million are rural residents
