

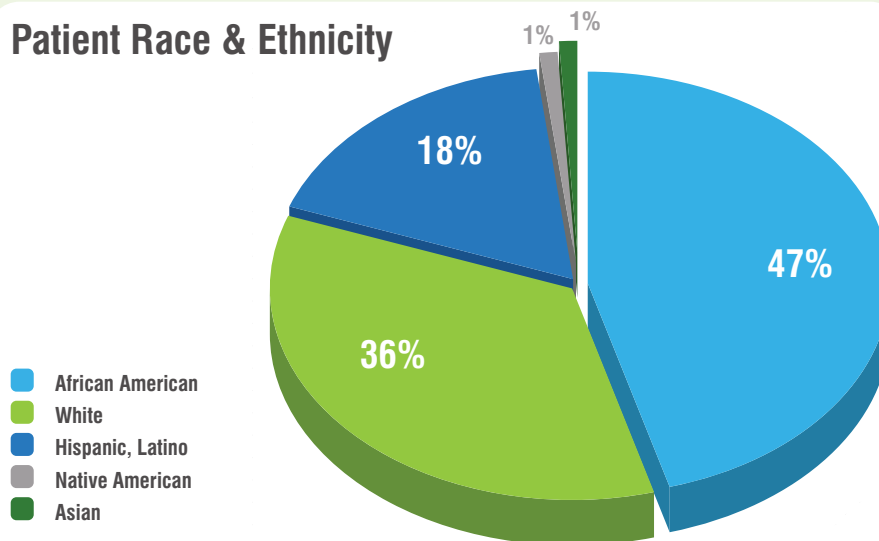

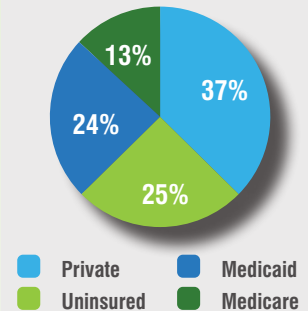
Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) in Georgia

- ◆ 34 FQHCs and 1 FQHC look-alike
- ◆ Serving over 766,045 patients
- ◆ Located in 141 counties with 413 clinic sites
- ◆ The mean annual rate of ER visits for uninsured patients is 25% less in counties with a FQHC compared to those without

A team of 4,716 dedicated professionals supported 2,403,072 patient visits.

U.S. FQHCs

- ◆ 1,512 FQHCs operate 17,000+ service locations in every state and territory
- ◆ FQHCs serve approximately 52 million patients or 1 in 7 Americans
- ◆ 4.1 million patients are 65 years or older
- ◆ FQHCs serve 1.5 million homeless patients
- ◆ 428,312 patients are veterans
- ◆ 145 million total patient visits
- ◆ 6.9 million dental patients
- ◆ 3.4 million behavioral health patients

Did you know that health centers in Georgia are economic drivers?

Brought over \$2 in economic activity for every dollar spent. For every 10 health center jobs, five additional jobs were created. In total, health centers in Georgia delivered \$1.6B in economic activity.



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
